

PARRS WOOD SIXTH FORM STUDENT AGREEMENT 2017-18

In order to ensure that Parrs Wood Sixth Form functions effectively and that all students maximise their potential in a safe and enjoyable environment, I agree to:

- Set the highest standards of conduct at all times, remembering that I am a role model within our high school
- Attend all lessons and tutor time punctually with expected equipment for that subject. Notify the Sixth Form office and teachers in advance if I know I will have an unavoidable absence (see the attendance policy) and ensure you see the staff from lessons missed to catch up on the work. It must be noted that poor attendance could result in being asked to pay for your exam entries
- Meet deadlines for homework and coursework
- Attend briefing every week, tutor time, Politics Day, Applications Day and Spiritual Awareness Day
- Keep the Common Room and Sixth Form Centre tidy
- Treat all students, staff and facilities at Parrs Wood with respect
- Wear my ID badge at all times whilst on site
- Not invite or encourage anybody who is not a member of Parrs Wood to come onto any part of the site (**doing so could result in permanent exclusion**)
- Dress in accordance with the Sixth Form dress code: show respect; not wear anything that obscures your identity; not wear sports team tops or clothing with offensive words or slogans; not wear clothing that endangers health and safety
- Respect the general school rules of not smoking or vaping on or around the site (anywhere within visibility of the school building) and not using mobile phones, iPods in class or in the main school buildings
- Not using of bringing any drugs into the school site or around Parrs Wood Complex (**doing so could result in permanent exclusion**)

I understand that failure to comply with any of the above will result in disciplinary action and may jeopardise my place in Parrs Wood Sixth Form.
